Sermon Title: *Know Jesus, Know Joy*

Text: Luke 2:4–14 (CSB)

Main Idea: Joy is not found in a season, but in a Savior.

No Jesus, no joy.

Know Jesus, know joy.

Point 1 – Thank God for _____

- God wrapped His **joy** in a **family**.
- God uses **ordinary, imperfect** people who simply say “**yes**” to Him.
- Every child needs more than someone who **brings** them into the world; they need someone who will **walk** with them in the world.
- God often builds His biggest blessings on the back of everyday **obedience**.

Point 2 – He’s Here: _____ Yourself Accordingly

- The good news first came to the **shepherds** out in the **fields**.
- The angel announces “**good news of great joy**.”
- This joy is for **all people** – including **me**.
- “A Savior was born **for you**” – this is not just information; it calls for a **response**.

Governing myself by the gospel looks like:

- Bringing my **fear** to Him instead of letting it rule me.
- Letting His “good news” be louder than my worst **news**.
- Treating Jesus as the **center** of my life, not an optional accessory.

Point 3 – A Party Like This One!

- Heaven **breaks out** in praise because **Jesus is here**.
- The angels’ song has two themes:
 - “Glory to God” – God’s **glory**.
 - “Peace on earth” – our **peace** with God.
- Heaven is celebrating not just what has happened, but what is going to happen – the cross, the empty tomb, the gift of the **Spirit**, and your salvation story.
- **Our joy is not based on the absence of problems, but on the presence of Jesus.**

No Jesus, no joy.

Know Jesus, know joy.
