## **Sermon 1: Priest**

**Scripture:** Hebrews 9:11–15 (CSB)

Jesus is the better High Priest who brings us to God through His once-for-all sacrifice, cleansing our conscience and securing our inheritance.

### **1) Jesus is the better High Priest who entered the better sanctuary (9:11)**

- Jesus is the High Priest “of the \_\_\_\_\_ that have come.”
- He entered the “greater and more perfect \_\_\_\_\_”
- It’s “not made with hands...not part of this creation.”

Our access to God is based on Christ’s priestly work, not an earthly system

### **2) Jesus secured eternal redemption with His own blood once for all (9:12)**

- “Once for all time” means the work is \_\_\_\_\_
- “Not by the blood of goats and calves” means the old sacrifices were \_\_\_\_\_
- But by His own blood. Jesus was the \_\_\_\_\_
- He obtained “eternal redemption.” Jesus’ purchase cannot be \_\_\_\_\_

The cross is finished, sufficient, and permanent

### **3) Jesus cleanses the conscience and frees us from dead works (9:13–14)**

- Old sacrifices purified outwardly (“the flesh”) but could not clean the \_\_\_\_\_
- Jesus’ sacrifice is perfect because He offered Himself “without blemish.”
- Jesus cleanses the conscience, not just the record
- He cleanses us from \_\_\_\_\_ works
- Purpose: so that we can \_\_\_\_\_ the living God

We don’t serve to be saved; we serve because we’ve been cleansed

### **4) Jesus is the mediator of a new covenant and secures our inheritance (9:15)**

- “Therefore,” means Jesus’ priestly work changes our standing with God
- Jesus is the \_\_\_\_\_: the One who brings two sides together
- New covenant means a new basis for a relationship: not external religion but \_\_\_\_\_
- The goal is “eternal inheritance”, not just forgiveness, but family
- His sacrifice is sufficient for all
